# SPORTS DAY



### This year's Sports Day will be held on FRIDAY 15 JUNE (weather permitting)

and we would be delighted if parents/carers could come along and support the pupils at 9.10 a.m. After dropping off the children parents must come back into school through the main office doors (*parents must stay on site during the event to ensure site safety – you cannot keep popping out*). Children should arrive at school wearing sports clothes and, if possible, these should be their house colour which are;

<b>Priory – Yellow</b>	<b>Tyne Bridge – Green</b>

Coloured sports bibs will be provided for children who do not have something in their house colour. Don't forget that the pupils will also need to bring a **bottle of STILL WATER** with them. However our sports day is not only for pupils because we will once again be holding our annual Parents/Carers Race so don't forget to bring your running shoes.

**PICNIC LUNCH** - We hope to make this a super community celebration so we have decided that a picnic lunch would be a marvellous way to end our morning of sports. Our picnic will take place in the playground at 12.00 and parents/carers are welcome to bring their own picnic to enjoy with their child. **Don't forget!** No hot meals will be prepared by our catering team on sports day. Pupils can either bring their own picnic lunch or order a school packed lunch by returning the order form tomorrow morning.

**BOOK LOOK** - After lunch parents/carers are welcome to make their way to their child's classroom for our Summer Term Book Look which will also provide an opportunity for parents/carers to speak to the class teacher. Children can leave any time after 2.00 providing they are accompanied by their parent/carer. Pupil's whose parents/carers are unable to join us will remain in school until 3.15 when they will be dismissed in the usual way.

**NURSERY SPORTS DAY** - Nursery will not be taking part in the main sports day as we feel these very young children will be overwhelmed by the larger school event. However they won't miss out, they will be having their own '**mini sports day**'. Parents/carers will be invited to join their children for this sporting celebration. No date has been set yet but we will let you know as soon as possible.

**RAINBOW ROOM** - Our tiny tots in the Rainbow Room will also be having their own mini sports day which will take place on **Thursday 15 June**. Parents are welcome to come along and support their child at 11.30. This event will take place in the Foundation Stage playground

### FOR WORKING FAMILIES

From September **we will** be offering 30 hours of FREE Nursery childcare for working parents providing they meet the criteria and obtain a code. There are set deadlines for obtaining the code so please, don't delay. **GET YOUR CODE NOW IF YOU WANT TO ACCESS THIS PROVISION IN SEPTEMBER.** We have re-issued the information letter today that was sent out earlier this term.

**IF YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FREE CHILDCARE** you can still obtain 30 hours of childcare. Every child of Nursery age is already entitled to 15 hours free childcare. Parents can opt to pay for an additional 15 hours. These additional sessions will be charged at £12.00 per session between Sept & Dec; we will be flexible regarding these top-up hours. However these top-up hours will have to be reviewed at Christmas as priority will be given to any new children accessing the 15 hours fully-funded places.
