Place value – learning about numbers up to 1,000,000 and how to order and compare them.

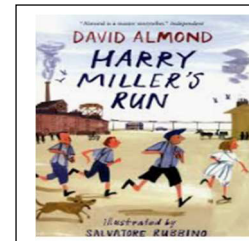
