We will be looking at and learning about toys from the past.

Topic Driver –
History



ENGLISH

English in year 1 will be taught through Read Write Inc and writing in our topic work with the purpose of writing to entertain.

We will say a sentence out loud before writing it down. (Hold a sentence)

We will practice and apply leaving spaces between words.

We will use the personal pronoun “I” in our writing.

We will practice using a capital letter at the start of a sentence.

We will find out about using capital letters for names of people, places and the days of the week.

We will practice sitting correctly at a table, holding a pencil comfortably and correctly.

We will use and apply our phonetic knowledge to spell unknown words.

HISTORY

We will discover historical concepts such as continuity and change.

We will learn about changes in living memory.

We will identify similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods.

This will come together by finding out about toys in the past and the materials that they were made from.

COMPUTING

We will learn how to use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private. We will identify where to go for help and support when we have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.

PSHRE

We will find out about our daily bedtime routine.

We will find out and explain what happens if you do not exercise regularly.

We will learn that other people have rights for their own body

We will discover foods that are good to have once a week.

We will identify hazard signs that mean something is dangerous and explain what germs are and why people need to keep clean.

PE

We will learn to move around whilst throwing and catching during team games.

MATHS

The main focus in maths will be on Place Value within 20. We will be finding one more and one less than a number and introducing greater than and less than. We will look at how to order and compare numbers to 20.

We will look at addition and subtraction, using part – whole models to support our learning. We will discover number bonds to 10 and learn about fact families.

RE

We will learn about our natural world and how to look after it. We will find out how people make preparations for a new baby.

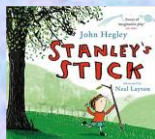

SCIENCE

We will distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made and be able to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

We will discover the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. We will compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

We will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead and have never been alive.

CREATIVE

In art we will be discovering and responding to the work of famous artists who use collage in their work.

In music we will be playing tuned and untuned instruments. We will listen to a range of high-quality live and recorded music. We will also experiment with, create, select and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.
