ENGLISH

Our English lessons will be focused around Drawing Club.

RE

GEOGRAPHY

Our focus this term will be on Weather and Seasons and this will link with Science.

We will focus on the identifying different weather types and how they effect our lives and the lives of others. This will also be a focus for the other seasons that we come across throughout the year.

MATHS

We will be exploring the relationship between numbers and introduce children to the important concept of equivalence; focus on the correct use of comparative language, as well as use of mathematical symbols (<, = and >).
