Equality

- 3. To foster good relations between persons who share relevant protected characteristics and persons who do not share it.

At Percy Main Primary, we are committed to ensuring equality of education, opportunity and treatment for all employees, pupils and any others involved in the school community particularly those who share relevant protected characteristics. We aim to ensure that those with relevant protected characteristics are not treated less favourably in any procedures, practices or service delivery, while also developing a culture of inclusion and diversity in which people feel free to disclose their needs and participate fully in school life. The achievement of all groups will be monitored and we will use this data to raise standards and ensure inclusive teaching. We will make reasonable adjustments to ensure the school environment is as accessible as possible.
