History

Children will learn about Mayan circa 900AD, they will learn about the advances of the early civilisation and will explore the tale of The two Heros by Dan Jolley. We will learn about who the Mayan's were and who they worshipped. We will learn about the Mayan Number system.

We will compare the Mayan civilisatin to another contemporary civilisation

RE

We are learning this term about Islam. We will explore the 5 pillars of Islam and the practices Muslims observe. We will learn about worship in a mosque and how Muslims care for others in the community.

COMPUTING

We will create adventure game stories inspired by Sinbad's voyages using 2create a story.

PSHRE

We will be learning about different relationships. We will explore who our important people and what love means and looks like in our family and friendships. We will understand the importance of self love. We will learn about how to deal with situations where others are unkind, and explore calming down strategies. We will learn how to share an opinion respectfully and how to react when we don't agree with someone else's opinion.

Aladdin Outcomes – defeating the monster tale

Maths

Fractions- we will learn about how to find equivalent fractions, how to simplify, order and compare fractions. We will learn how to add and subtract fractions and mixed numbers and how to convert between improper fractions and mixed numbers.

Fractions, decimals and percentages -

We will learn how to express fractions as decimals up to three decimal points. We will learn the place value of decimal numbers, how to add them and how to compare them. We will convert between fractions decimals and percentages and compare and order these numbers.

PE

We will explore different types of dance. We will learn different moves and put them together to choreograph sequences to different types of music.

Music

In our music lessons we will learn to perform glockenspiels learning how to read crotchets and quavers and rests. We will also learn to read the notes that we play on a stave and will play in unison.

SCIENCE

We will be learning about light and how we see. We will learn about how light travels and enters the eye, how we see different colours, how the eye works. We will learn the different parts of the eye and how the eye works. We will write an explanation text detailing how we see.

Art

We will explore the work of Hundertwasser. We will compare this to the architecture of ancient Baghdad. We will dip dye fabric and create line drawings onto the fabric inspired by the architecture of ancient Baghdad. We will create press prints using these lines drawings and print these onto fabric
