Children will continue to focus on reasoning style questions to derive which operation is required.

Fractions, decimals and percentages -

We will learn how to express fractions as decimals up to three decimal points. We will learn the place value of decimal numbers, how to add them and how to compare them. We will convert between fractions decimals and percentages and compare and order these numbers.

#### SCIENCE

We will be learning to describe changes as humans develop to old age. We will identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

We will recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way our bodies function. We will learn to describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans.

#### COMPUTING

We will learn how to use spreadsheets and create spreadsheets that manipulate

different sets of data.

## PE

We will explore different types of dance. We will learn different moves and put them together to choreograph sequences to different types of music.

### Music

In our music lessons we will learn to perform glockenspiels learning how to read crotchets and guavers and rests. We will also learn to read the notes that we play on a stave and will play in unison.

### DT

We will explore the benefits and foundations of a healthy diet. We will find out about seasonal produce and design, prepare and make a meal using these ingredients.
