Year 1 - Summer Term 2024

What can you grow?

ENGLISH

Our English lessons will be focused on stamina within writing quality, using our phonic sounds and spellings, sentence and story structure and imagination through storytelling.

We will focus on understanding how 'and' is used appropriately to extend sentences and how a full stop allows the reader to breath.

We will also focus on different writing concepts: suffix endings -ing, -ed, -est, -er; how -s or -es is needed when creating plural words; adding the prefix -un to make a new word and capital letters for proper nouns.

We will continue to include letter formation, capital letters, full stops and finger spaces as non-negotiables.

This is our time to continue to embed and put our learning in practice.

Drawing Club

Writing Outcomes: 5-part story writing

Imitation: we will focus on the text to write a 5 part story.

The focus will be on the children writing dictated sentences to support their phonic sounds and spelling.

Invention: the children will create their own 5 part story based on a structure to support them.

LIFE SKILLS

We will focus on living in the wider world and how we can approach that and prepare for it and then focus on the country we live in and how we can be positive citizens.

NOVEL STUDY

SCIENCE

Our focus this term will be about plants and growing our own in school. We will plant in our school garden and create a garden area.
